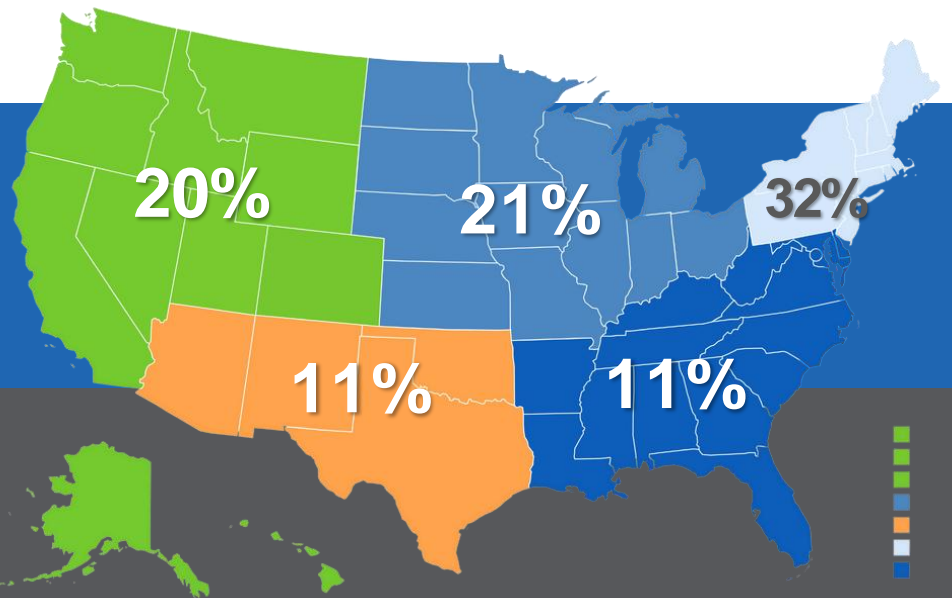


Who is Exponent Philanthropy?

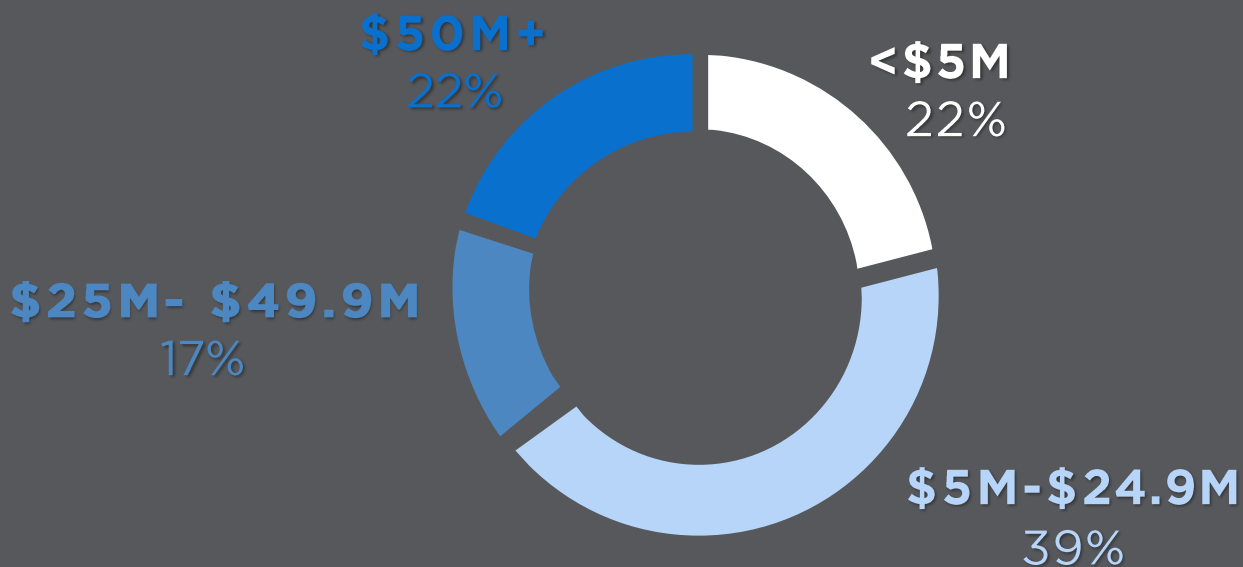

Designed by and for lean funders, Exponent Philanthropy's Annual Conference offers an inspiring opportunity for more than 500 philanthropic leaders from across the country to come together for in-person learning, connecting, and sharing.

Hosted each fall, our Annual Conference has a strong reputation for engaging the head and heart, providing meaningful opportunities to connect and learn, and radiating a welcoming culture that builds a supportive community of peers.

The Conference Agenda?

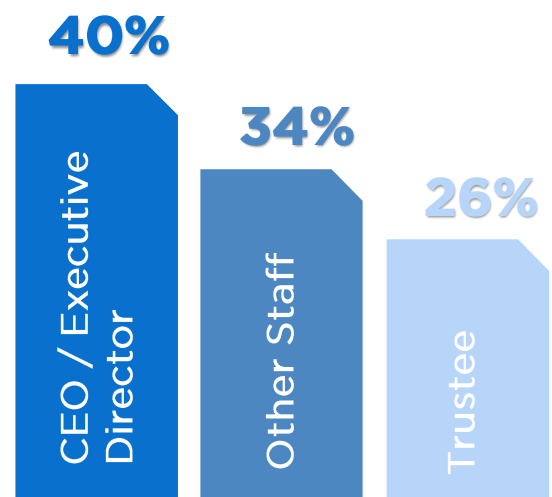
The conference agenda spans a wide range of philanthropy-related topics and offers a variety of session formats to meet all learning styles. The program will include 40+ sessions, workshops, thought-provoking plenaries, site visits, and a multitude of informal learning and networking opportunities that build connection, strengthen skills, provide inspiration, and explore trends.

Plans for the 2026 Conference include:

- Pre-Con:** Full and half-day retreats for CEOs, trustees, and Next Gen Fellows, 990PF workshop, Champions Reception, and dine-arounds
- Day 1:** Opening plenary, in-depth learning sessions, community site visits, exhibit hall, peer networking, and dine-arounds
- Day 2:** Topic-based sessions, member-led workshops, fundamental- to expert-level learning opportunities, plenaries, exhibit hall, and off-site community reception
- Day 3:** Deep dive sessions, issue area roundtables, Annual Member Meeting, and closing plenary

Expected Attendance

We anticipate welcoming more than 500 attendees, including foundation staff and trustees, individual donors, philanthropic families, corporate philanthropists, and philanthropic advisors to join us for three days of learning, networking, and sharing.

Provide scholarships for lean funders with limited resources. Your support will assist in offering top-notch learning experiences for the volunteers, staff, and trustees of organizations with limited resources, including grantmaking public charities, giving circles, all volunteer run organizations, newly created foundations, and others. *Support at this level begins at \$15,000.*

Support Role-, Identity- and Issue-Specific Retreats and Gathering Spaces. Exponent Philanthropy is honored to host retreats and gathering spaces for specific role-, identity- and-issue based groups (ex: CEOs, Trustees, BIPOC funders, disaster philanthropy, impact investing, etc.) and provide unique spaces where lean funders can gather with their peers. *Support at this level begins at \$10,000.*

Support local site visits. Experiencing the local community is always one of the highlights of the conference. Support a site visit to a local neighborhood, an exemplary community project, or a local nonprofit gem. *Support at this level begins at \$7,500.*

Support local arts, culture, and businesses. Help us showcase Portland's vibrant arts, culture, culinary, and small business scene. Underwrite the costs associated with adding local performers, artists, and vendors throughout the conference and fairly compensate them for their time and services. *Support begins at \$5,000.*

Support a conference session or workshop. Help ensure we can deliver a wide variety of conference sessions, formats, and topics by supporting a conference session that aligns with your mission, interests, and/or strategies. *Support at this level begins at \$5,000.*
